

## SOUTH AFRICA MISSION (CONT.) —

### REGISTER NOW FOR THE SOUTH AFRICA MISSION

Over the last year the St. Peter's community has raised over \$25,000 to help build a home for children in South Africa orphaned by HIV/AIDS. The house has now been built, the floors will soon be painted and furniture moved in, making a dream become reality for six children and a house mother. This journey will continue as a group of St. Peter's families travels in the summer of 2011 to South Africa to support the children in this home and possibly begin work on a second home.

If you want to be part of this mission trip, you need to register with a non-refundable deposit no later than October 31, 2010.

Mission details:

Mission Dates:	July 30 to August 5, 2011 Note: The actual mission work will run from Monday, August 1, through Friday, August 5. The organizers anticipate having most participants travel to and from South Africa together in order to obtain reduced airfares, as well as allowing some amount of personal time after the mission work is completed for people to explore South Africa on their own. Thus, the expectation is that dates of group travel will likely run from as early as July 28 through August 12 to 15. Travel to South Africa takes about 24 hours, <u>not</u> including adjustment to the local time upon arrival (there is a six-hour difference in time, and travelers leave Washington in the evening and arrive in Cape Town close to midnight the following day).
Location:	Masiphumelele, near Simons Town, the Western Cape, South Africa
Age Requirements:	Minimum age is 6. All minors must be accompanied by a parent. Children 16 and up may be accompanied by a non-parent guardian with review from the committee.
Group Size:	A maximum of 35 people may participate in the mission (including five to six group leaders).
Cost:	All mission participants must bear their own costs for accommodation expenses and travel to and from South Africa. Travel costs for mission participants may be tax deductible; consult your tax professional. Fundraising efforts are underway to help defray some of the travel expenditures for youth going on the mission.
Budget:	Airfare is estimated to be between \$1200 and \$1600 per person round trip between Washington and Cape Town. Accommodations will be approximately \$15 a day (not including meals) staying at Rocklands Christian Centre in Simons Town. The church will work with airlines to secure group rates where possible. The church will cover some expenditures such as local group ground transportation.
Training:	All adults participating in the mission <b>MUST</b> complete the required diocesan training on the prevention of child abuse.
Responsibilities:	All participants are expected to actively support fundraising events over the course of the year. All participants must also sign the mission rules, responsibilities and release forms.

A non-refundable deposit of \$200 per person is needed no later than October 31, 2010, to secure your place in the mission.
