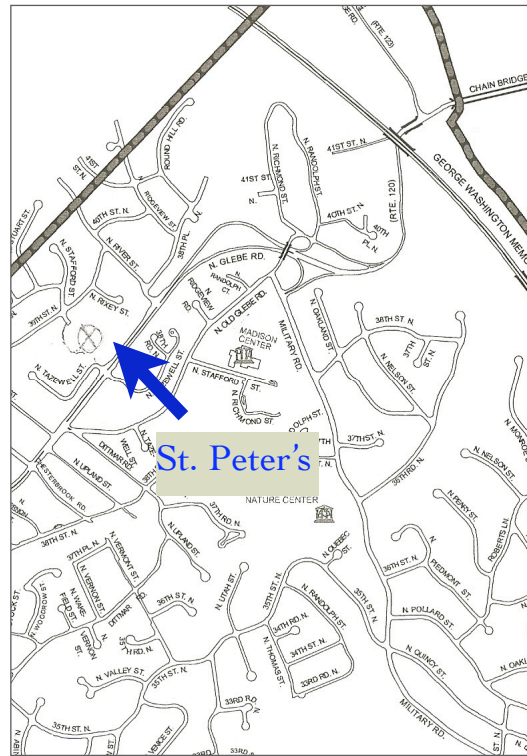

# St. Peter's February-March 2010 Adult Forums Schedule

## **February 7 – Fifth Sunday After the Epiphany**

*Option I* – Planning Team Final Report. The Planning Team will present the results of their work over the last year. (Snowed out.)

*Option II* – Saint Xavier, led by Margaret Cohea. An introduction to this 16th-century Basque missionary who travelled extensively in India and the Far East. She will address how studying him (or any other saint for that matter) can impact the modern world and St. Peter's in particular. (Snowed out.)

## **February 14 – Last Sunday After the Epiphany**

*Option I* – The Arts in Worship, led by Meta Phillips.

*Option II* – Mission Opportunities Panel, led by members of the St. Peter's Mission Commission. Come learn about the variety of ways in which St. Peter's serves the community locally and farther afield.

## **February 21 – First Sunday in Lent**

*Option I* – Benedictine Virtues, Part 1, led by The Rev. Dr. Craig Phillips. As we prepare for the “observance of a Holy Lent,” the rector will examine resources from the Benedictine tradition that are at the heart of Anglican spirituality. Over the course of two sessions, topics will include the balance of work and prayer, listening (obedience to God), *lectio divina*, “prayer of the hours,” and stability.

*Option II* – Shrine Mont Summer Camps, led by Paris Ball from the Diocese of Virginia.

## **February 28 – Second Sunday in Lent**

*Option I* – Julian of Norwich, led by Margaret Cohea and Catharine Gibson. This contemporary of Chaucer made creative use of feminine imagery in her description of God and is regarded as a pioneer of contemplative prayer.

*Option II* – Planning Team Final Report, led by the Planning Team. Members of the Planning Team will be available after the 9AM and 11AM services to discuss the report they compiled over the course of several presentations to the parish on the church building.

## **March 7 – Third Sunday in Lent**

*Option I* – Teach Us To Pray: Part II, led by the St. Peter's Prayer Group. A discussion of the different sorts of prayer in the Anglican tradition based on a preaching series by the Anglican Society of St. John the Evangelist in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

*Option II* – St. Peter's Mission involvement in Kenya, led by Kenya Task Force. An update on the Mission Commission's involvement with The Rev. Samuel Sudhe in Kenya. St. Peter's hosted Samuel as a priest associate in 2005 and has maintained contact with him and his village over the past several years.

## **3/14 – Fourth Sunday in Lent**

*Option I* – Benedictine Virtues, Part 2, led by The Rev. Dr. Craig A. Phillips. As we prepare for the “observance of a Holy Lent,” the rector will examine resources from the Benedictine tradition that are at the heart of Anglican spirituality. Over the course of two sessions, topics will include the balance of work and prayer, listening (obedience to God), *lectio divina*, “prayer of the hours,” and stability.

*Option II* – Parish Retreat to Shrine Mont, led by Lisa Lettau. An overview of the activities and opportunities for involvement at the popular parish retreat weekend in April.

## **3/21 – Fifth Sunday in Lent**

*Option I* – Stephen Ministry Series: Grief and Loss, led by The Rev. Charlie Spigner.

*Option II* – Being a Seminarian, led by Laura Doud Cochran. Laura is now nearing the end of her first year as a seminarian at Virginia Theological Seminary and will discuss her impressions of life as a seminarian.
